## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that an entity that is not a human may not call itself a nurse or similar title. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.3).

Prohibits a nonhuman entity from using [the title "nurse" or other similar titles] specified nursing titles and abbreviations.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the use of nursing titles. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 678.010 to 5 678.410. SECTION 2. A nonhuman entity, including but not limited to an agent powered by arti-6 ficial intelligence, may not use any of the following titles: 8 (1) Advanced Practice Registered Nurse or the abbreviation APRN; (2) Certified registered nurse anesthetist or the abbreviation CRNA; 10 (3) Clinical nurse specialist or the abbreviation CNS; 11 (4) Licensed practical nurse or the abbreviation LPN; (5) Registered nurse or the abbreviation RN; 13 (6) Nurse practitioner or the abbreviation NP; (7) Certified medication aide or the abbreviation CMA; or 14 15 (8) Certified nursing assistant or the abbreviation CNA. 16
