House Bill 2754

SUMMARY

It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act stops a landlord from barring or limiting a tenancy based on a tenant's ideas. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.6).

Prohibits viewpoint discrimination by nonresidential landlords.

2	Relating to viewpoint discrimination in nonresidential tenancies.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 91.010 to 91.110.
5	SECTION 2. (1) A landlord may not, as a condition of entering into a tenancy, or as a
6	term of the tenancy, discriminate against a tenant based on a tenant's viewpoint or tenant's
7	expression of that viewpoint privately or within the leased premises.
8	(2) As used in this section:
9	(a) "Viewpoint" includes any religious, political or ideological belief.
10	(b) "Viewpoint" does not include any expression of:
11	(A) Explicit support for violent, criminal or antisocial behavior; or
12	(B) Animus toward other persons, relating to their race, color, religion, gender identity,
13	sexual orientation, disability or national origin.
