House Bill 2768

Sponsored by Representative EVANS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells ODEM to contract with one or more persons to help acquire and use resources for emergencies. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.3).

Directs the Oregon Department of Emergency Management to contract with one or more philanthropic liaisons. Specifies the minimum duties of philanthropic liaisons.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to philanthropic liaisons for emergency preparedness; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Department of Emergency Management shall contract with

- 5 one or more persons to serve as philanthropic liaisons for the department.
- 6 (2) The department shall specify the duties of a philanthropic liaison by contract. Such
- 7 duties must include:

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8 (a) Improving coordination between private and public resources available for emergency

9 preparedness; and

- 10 (b) Acting as liaison between the following entities to coordinate procurement and dis-
- 11 **tribution of resources:**
- 12 (A) The department;
- 13 (B) State and national philanthropic entities;
- 14 (C) Community organizations active in disaster;
- 15 (D) Long-term recovery groups;
- 16 (E) Other community organizations; and
- 17 (F) Survivors of an emergency.

18 (3) A philanthropic liaison is an independent contractor and is not a state agency for any

19 purpose.

20 (4) As used in this section:

(a) "Community organization active in disaster" means an organization or network of
organizations that is prepared to address emergency prevention, preparedness, response and
recovery at a local level.

(b) "Long-term recovery group" means a cooperative organization comprising represen tatives of nonprofit, governmental, business and faith-based entities that works within a lo cal community to prepare for, build resilience against and recover from emergencies.

27 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 29 on its passage.
