House Bill 2793

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes a hospital report on what it spends to counter efforts by labor to organize. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Requires a hospital to report on the amount of money the hospital spends on strategies to discourage, avoid or prevent labor organizing.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to actions by a hospital on labor organizing.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A hospital licensed under ORS 441.025 shall report annually to the Bureau

5 of Labor and Industries and the Oregon Health Authority the amount of money the hospital

6 spends, if any, on third parties to consult on or implement strategies to discourage, avoid

7 or prevent labor organizing.

8 (2) A hospital shall report the information described in subsection (1) of this section in 9 the form and manner prescribed by the Bureau of Labor and Industries.
