House Bill 2794

Sponsored by Representative NELSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells a health care facility to make a process that a staff member may use to complain if the staff member believes in good faith supply or equipment is not safe. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.7).

Directs a health care facility to establish and maintain procedures that a staff member may use to submit to the health care facility a complaint regarding a medical supply or equipment that the staff member believes in good faith is faulty or dangerous.

Requires the health care facility to retain a complaint and associated information for 10 years, inform a person if the health care facility uses, has used or stops using a medical supply or equipment that is subject to a complaint and establish and maintain procedures that a person may use to obtain a copy of a complaint and associated information.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

5 (a) "Associated information" means information gathered in the investigation of or in

6 response to a complaint submitted by a staff person regarding a medical supply or equipment that a health care facility uses in the provision of care. 7

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(b) "Health care facility" has the meaning given that term in ORS 441.015.

(c) "Staff person" means an individual employee or contracted worker who works at or 9 for a health care facility. 10

(2) A health care facility shall: 11

(a) Establish and maintain procedures that a staff person may use to submit to the 12 health care facility a complaint regarding a medical supply or equipment that the health care 13 facility uses in the provision of care if the staff person believes in good faith that the medical 14 15supply or equipment is faulty or dangerous;

16 (b) Retain a copy of a complaint submitted under this section and associated information for a period of 10 years from the date a complaint is submitted to the health care facility; 17

(c) Inform a person if the health care facility uses or, within the last 10 years, has used 18 in the provision of care for the person a medical supply or equipment that is subject to a 19 20 complaint retained under this section;

21(d) Inform a person that the health care facility no longer uses a medical supply or 22equipment if:

(A) Within the last 10 years, the health care facility has used the medical supply or 2324 equipment in the provision of care for the person;

(B) The health care facility stops using the medical supply or equipment; and 25

26 (C) The medical supply or equipment is subject to a complaint retained under this sec1 tion; and

2 (e) Establish and maintain procedures that a person may use to request and obtain a 3 copy of a complaint and associated information retained under this section regarding a 4 medical supply or equipment that the health care facility uses or, within the last 10 years,

5 $\,$ has used in the provision of care for the person.

(3)(a) The Oregon Health Authority shall adopt rules for health care facilities, except long
 term care facilities, to carry out the provisions of this section.

- 8 (b) The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules for long term care facilities to
 9 carry out the provisions of this section.
- 10 (c) Rules adopted under this subsection must:
- 11 (A) Provide for uniform standards and procedures; and
- (B) Protect against disclosure of protected health information and other information
 subject to state or federal laws limiting the disclosure of health information.
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
