

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2806

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “ORS” delete the rest of the line and delete line 3  
2 and insert “618.136 and 618.141; and repealing section 4, chapter 385, Oregon Laws 2019.”.

3 Delete line 5.

4 In line 6, delete “2” and insert “1”.

5 On page 2, line 36, delete “3” and insert “2”.

6 In line 39, delete “seven” and insert “10”.

7 In line 41, delete “seven” and insert “10”.

8 After line 42, insert:

9 **“SECTION 3. Section 4, chapter 385, Oregon Laws 2019, is repealed.**

10 **“SECTION 4.** ORS 618.136, as amended by section 2, chapter 385, Oregon Laws 2019, is  
11 amended to read:

12 “618.136. (1) The license fee for each type or class of commercial weighing or measuring in-  
13 strument or device shall be established by the State Department of Agriculture in an amount not  
14 to exceed the maximum limits under ORS 618.141. Such fees shall be established in the amounts  
15 necessary for the department to carry out and enforce the provisions of ORS 618.010 to 618.246 re-  
16 lating to the supervision of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or devices, and to  
17 maintain an emergency fund with an unencumbered balance in an amount not to exceed the cost  
18 of administering ORS 618.010 to 618.246 during a representative four-month period in order to ensure  
19 the orderly supervision of commercial weighing and measuring instruments or devices within this  
20 state.

21 “(2) License fees become past due July 1 each year for renewals, and on the date of first com-  
22 mercial use for original installations.

23 **“(3) Except as provided in this subsection, the department may not establish a license fee**  
24 **under this section that is more than three percent higher than the license fee charged during**  
25 **the preceding year for a commercial weighing or measuring instrument or device of the same**  
26 **type and class. Notwithstanding the three percent limit but subject to the maximum limits**  
27 **under ORS 618.141, when establishing a license fee under this section the department may**  
28 **round the fee amount to the next higher whole dollar amount. The department may not**  
29 **change the license fee for the same type and class of commercial weighing or measuring in-**  
30 **strument or device more than once each year.**

31 “[3)] (4) All moneys received by the department pursuant to ORS 618.010 to 618.246 shall be  
32 paid into the Department of Agriculture Service Fund. Such moneys are continuously appropriated  
33 to the department for the purpose of administering those provisions of ORS 618.010 to 618.246 re-  
34 lating to testing, inspection, licensing and regulation of commercial weighing and measuring instru-  
35 ments or devices.”.
