SUMMARY

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
6	made to the Water Resources Department, by . for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) There is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund, the Groundwater Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Match Fund. Interest earned by the Groundwater Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Match Fund shall be credited to the fund.

- (2)(a) All moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Water Resources Department to provide the state contribution for water users who cancel ground water rights as part of enrollment in the federal Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (16 U.S.C. 3831a).
- (b) This subsection applies only to water users in areas in which the department is not allowing new rights to use ground water for irrigation.
- (3) The fund shall consist of all moneys credited to the fund, including moneys appropriated or transferred to the fund by the Legislative Assembly.
- SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Water Resources Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for deposit in the Groundwater Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Match Fund established under section 2 of this 2025 Act for the

4	SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
5	expenditures established by, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum
6	limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous
7	Receipts, and including federal funds received under cooperative agreements with or con-
8	tracts from the Bureau of Reclamation of the United States Department of the Interior, the
9	United States Army Corps of Engineers, the United States Geological Survey, the Bonneville
10	Power Administration and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, but excluding lottery
11	funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Water
12	Resources Department, for technical services, is increased by \$500,000, for authorized
13	expenditures of moneys deposited in the Groundwater Conservation Reserve Enhancement
14	Program Match Fund established under section 2 of this 2025 Act.
15	SECTION 5. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
16	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
17	on its passage.
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
