House Bill 2815

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Governor Tina Kotek for Department of Early Learning and Care)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the Department of Early Learning and Care to study options to support

early learning and care for tribes. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.6).

Requires the Department of Early Learning and Care to study options for supporting tribal early learning and care in this state. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to early learning and care not later than September 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to tribal early learning services.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The Department of Early Learning and Care shall study options for supporting tribal early learning and care in this state. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to early learning and care no later than September 15, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
