House Bill 2818

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells OHA to study potential changes to one of its programs. (Flesch Readability Score: 69.9).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study potential changes to the coordinated care organization quality incentive program administered by the authority. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health not later than September 15, 2026.

7 include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative As-

8 sembly related to health no later than September 15, 2026.

9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

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
