

House Bill 2831

Sponsored by Representative EVANS (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells police agencies to make a board to look at the policies of the agency and make a report to DPSST. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Requires a law enforcement agency to designate a police oversight board to annually review policies of the agency and report to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to police oversight boards.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. A law enforcement agency, as defined in ORS 181A.010, shall designate a**
5 **police oversight board composed of public members with diverse perspectives. The police**
6 **oversight board shall annually review the policies of the law enforcement agency and report**
7 **to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training on the review.**
