SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DAS to give out for programs for giving free childcare to people to do government business. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.8).

Appropriates moneys to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to

an organization and Polk County for [expanding a program] programs for providing free drop-in childcare for people with business at a county courthouse or with other governmental business and data collection regarding the [program] programs.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to childcare programs for people with governmental business; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$210,000 for distribution to Marion County Lawyers Charitable Corporation for purposes of expanding a program for providing free drop-in childcare for people with business at a county courthouse or with other governmental business and data collection regarding the program.

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$210,000 for distribution to Polk County for a program for providing free drop-in childcare for people with business at a county courthouse or with other governmental business and data collection regarding the program.

SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.
