

House Bill 2920

Sponsored by Representative NELSON; Senator MANNING JR (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes a hospital give to the OHA and make public on a website certain fiscal data. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.6).

Requires a hospital to report to the Oregon Health Authority and make publicly available securities data and disclosures that the hospital provides to the federal Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board.

2 Relating to the disclosure of financial information.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 442.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) A hospital licensed in this state shall report to the Oregon Health Au-**
6 **thority and make publicly available on the hospital's website securities data and disclosure**
7 **documents that the hospital provides and makes publicly available on a website operated by**
8 **the federal Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board established under 15 U.S.C. 78o-4(b).**

9 **(2) A hospital shall report to the authority and make publicly available the information**
10 **described under subsection (1) of this section:**

11 **(a) Within 24 hours of providing the information to the federal Municipal Securities**
12 **Rulemaking Board, or as frequently as required by the authority; and**

13 **(b) In a form and manner required by the authority.**

14 **(3) If a hospital does not have a website, the information described under subsection (1)**
15 **of this section must be made available in hard copy form in each reception area of the hos-**
16 **pital.**

17 **(4) The information that must be reported to the authority under this section is in ad-**
18 **dition to and not in lieu of the reporting requirements in ORS 442.386 or 442.425 or other**
19 **similar provisions.**
