

House Bill 2984

Sponsored by Representatives HELM, OWENS (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to an agency for deposit into a certain fund. The Act says that the money must be used for activities related to water. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.6).

Appropriates moneys to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife out of the General Fund for deposit into the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to funding for activities concerning water; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the**
5 **biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000, for de-**
6 **posit into the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund established by ORS 496.252 for ac-**
7 **tivities described in ORS 496.252 (2) that relate to water.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
