

House Bill 3001

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act provides resources for Black adults in custody. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.1). Appropriates moneys out of the General Fund to the Department of Corrections to provide housing and employment reentry services to Black adults in custody.

Relating to adults in custody.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Corrections, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended to provide culturally specific housing and employment reentry services to Black adults in custody at a correctional facility, as defined in ORS 30.642.
