## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3007

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 29. 1 2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 32 and insert: "SECTION 1. ORS 336.495 is amended to read: 3 "336.495. [(1) The Department of Education shall develop a form for public education programs to 4  $\mathbf{5}$ use when a student has been diagnosed with a concussion or other brain injury.] 6 "[(2) The form required under this section must describe academic accommodations that a public 7 education program may make for a student who has been diagnosed with a concussion or other brain injury. The accommodations must be optional for a public education program to provide and must be 8 9 nonmedical.] 10 "[(3)(a) The department must distribute the form developed under this section to public education 11 programs.] 12"[(b) The department must make the form developed under this section available for use by educa-13tors and other program employees, students, parents and guardians.] 14 "(4)(a) A public education program must make the form developed under this section available as 15soon as practicable to an educator, a program employee, a student, a parent or a guardian when:] 16 "[(A) The public education program receives notice that a student has been diagnosed with a concussion or other brain injury; or] 17 18 "[(B) Requested by an educator, a program employee, a student, a parent or a guardian.] 19 "[(b) Nothing in this subsection requires a public education program to provide any or all of the 20 academic accommodations described on the form.] 21"[(5) The State Board of Education may adopt any rules necessary for the implementation of this 22section.] 23"(1) As used in this section: 24"(a) 'Health care professional' means a person who is licensed or registered under the 25laws of this state as a physician, a chiropractic physician, a naturopathic physician, a psy-26chologist, a physical therapist, an occupational therapist, a physician associate or a nurse 27practitioner. 28"(b) 'Public education provider' means a school district, a public charter school or an 29education service district. "(2)(a) The Department of Education shall establish a procedure for public education 30 31 providers to use to develop and implement an immediate and temporary accommodations 32plan for a student who has been diagnosed with a concussion or other brain injury by a 33 health care professional to ensure the safety and recovery of the student and to reduce the 34 risk of reinjury or additional injury to the student. 35(b) The department shall prepare a sample form, and include written instructions for

the sample form, to assist public education providers in following the procedure to develop 1 2 and implement an immediate and temporary accommodations plan.

"(3) Upon receiving written notification from a parent or guardian that a student has 3 4 been diagnosed with a concussion or other brain injury by a health care professional and that accommodations are being requested, a public education provider shall initiate the procedure 5 to develop and implement an immediate and temporary accommodations plan. 6

7 "(4) The procedure to develop and implement an immediate and temporary accommodations plan shall be used by a public education provider to: 8

"(a) Determine if immediate physical activity limitations are necessary to ensure the 9 safety and recovery of the student and to minimize the risk of reinjury or additional injury 10 11 to the student, including activities such as physical education, recess, unstructured play and similar activities provided by or sponsored through the public education provider that involve 12running, jumping, climbing, throwing, catching or other movements that pose a risk of falls, 13collisions or physical injury. The public education provider shall implement any immediate 14 15physical activity limitations determined to be necessary.

"(b) Describe present challenges and symptoms associated with the student's concussion 16 or other brain injury. 17

18 "(c) Identify and implement immediate and temporary academic, social-emotional, be-19 havioral or other necessary accommodations determined to be appropriate for the student 20to support meaningful participation in educational activities at a level that is appropriate for 21the student's recovery.

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"(d) Communicate accommodations identified under paragraph (c) of this subsection with:

"(A) All teachers who provide instruction to the student; and

"(B) Other employees of the public education provider who have regular responsibilities 24 for the student's supervision or health, including school nurses, counselors, physical educa-25 26tion teachers, coaches, athletic trainers and staff supervising recess or other physical ac-27tivities.

"(e) Ensure that the accommodations identified under paragraph (c) of this subsection 2829are:

"(A) In effect no later than 10 days after written notification has been received by the 30 public education provider regarding the concussion or other brain injury; and 31

"(B) Reviewed as needed, but no later than every two months, based on the student's 3233 recovery.

(5) The department shall make available to all public education providers the procedure 34and sample form developed under this section.". 35

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
