In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-4 ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 5 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$9,000,500, for distribution to Portland State 6 University to fund recruitment and retention payments to child care providers working in 7 Oregon through the Oregon Center for Career Development in Childhood Care and Educa-8 tion. 9 SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-10 ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 11 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,455,109, for distribution to child care 12

13 workforce training programs.

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
