7	University to fund recruitment and retention payments to child care providers working in
8	Oregon through the Oregon Center for Career Development in Childhood Care and Educa-

10	SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
11	ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July
12	1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$, for distribution to United We Heal
13	Training Trust to provide health care benefits to child care providers.
14	SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
15	ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July
16	1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$, for distribution to child care
17	workforce training programs.
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
