House Bill 3017

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would tell OHA to study the risks to human health of chemicals in some pro-

ducts. (Flesch Readability Score: 75.1).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study the risks to human health of chemicals in menstrual, intimate care and incontinence products. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to public health no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to chemicals in products.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3
 - SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study the risks to human health of chemicals in menstrual, intimate care and incontinence products. The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to public health no later than September 15, 2026.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027. 9

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
