SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells OHCS to study homelessness. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.7). Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to study homelessness. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to housing not later than September 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to homelessness. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Housing and Community Services Department shall study issues regarding homelessness. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the

Legislative Assembly related to housing no later than September 15, 2026.
