SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives moneys to HECC for the SCYP at UO. The Act declares an emergency.

The Act becomes law on July 1, 2025. (Flesch Readability Score: 75.3).

Appropriates moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to the Sustainable City Year Program at the University of Oregon.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the Sustainable City Year Program at the University of Oregon; and declaring an emergency. 3
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$600,000, for distribution to the Sustainable City Year Program at the University of Oregon for the purpose of developing sustainability policy support for local communities through the connection with appropriate students at public universities in this state.
 - SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.
