House Bill 3126

Sponsored by Representative OWENS; Representative MCINTIRE (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the TSPC to create a pilot program to license some types of teachers. (Flesch Readability Score: 79.8).

Directs the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to establish by rule a five-year pilot program to license teachers other than career and technical education teachers in this state in a manner similar to the career and technical education teaching license program.

Sunsets on January 2, 2031.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to licensure of teachers providing classroom instruction in subjects other than career and 3 technical education.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission shall by rule establish a 6 five-year pilot program to license teachers other than career and technical education teach-7 ers in this state in a manner similar to the career and technical education teaching license 8 program adopted by rule by the commission. 9 (2) The rules must:

(a) Allow for a school district, in partnership with a Regional Educator Network estab lished by the Educator Advancement Council, to convene an instructor appraisal committee.

12 (b) Target teacher candidates seeking to provide classroom instruction on subjects other

than career and technical education, including but not limited to, math, science and social studies.

(c) Require teacher candidates to receive mentorship through the local Regional Educa tor Network.

17 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed January 2, 2031.

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
