

House Bill 3169

Sponsored by Representative MARSH (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells OHA to adjust grants to school-based health centers for inflation. (Flesch Readability Score: 69.9).

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to modify the amounts of grants for school-based health centers for inflation.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to school-based health centers; and declaring an emergency.

2 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

3 **SECTION 1. (1) Grants awarded to school-based health centers by the Oregon Health**
4 **Authority under ORS 413.225 (4)(a) must be for a minimum annual amount of \$70,000, ad-**
5 **justed under subsection (2) of this section.**

6 **(2) To account for effects of inflation, the authority shall, by rule, annually adjust the**
7 **dollar amount specified in subsection (1) of this section based on the Consumer Price Index**
8 **for All Urban Consumers, West Region (All Items), as published by the Bureau of Labor**
9 **Statistics of the United States Department of Labor.**

10 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
11 **ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
12 **General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended to carry out the provisions**
13 **of section 1 of this 2025 Act.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
16 **July 1, 2025.**
