House Bill 3198

Sponsored by Representative SANCHEZ (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DOJ to study missing and murdered indigenous people and make a report. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Requires the Department of Justice to study missing and murdered indigenous people. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to public safety not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to missing and murdered indigenous people.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The Department of Justice shall study missing and murdered indigenous people. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to public safety no later than September 15, 2026.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
