Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.". 1213 Delete line 24 and insert: 14 "(a) Assessing and documenting cybersecurity vulnerabilities and the specific cybersecurity in-15surance coverage requirements that the public bodies are unable to meet; 16"(b) Meeting cybersecurity insurance coverage requirements; 17 "(c) Cybersecurity training; and". 18 In line 25, delete "(b)" and insert "(d)". 19
