## AN ACT

Relating to exemption of property owned by a limited equity cooperative; creating new provisions; amending ORS 307.520; and prescribing an effective date.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 307.520 is amended to read:

307.520. (1) Property or a portion of property owned by a limited equity cooperative is exempt from taxation as provided under ORS 307.515 to 307.523 if:

(a) The property is occupied by low income persons holding a proprietary lease in the limited equity cooperative;

(b) The charges paid by the occupant to the limited equity cooperative for occupancy reflect the full value of the property tax exemption;

(c) The exemption has been approved as provided in ORS 307.523, pursuant to an application filed before July 1, 2030; and

[(d) The housing units on the property were constructed, or converted to limited equity cooperative ownership, after the local governing body adopted the provisions of ORS 307.515 to 307.523; and]

[(e)] (d) The information disclosed on the application filed pursuant to ORS 307.521 meets any other criteria adopted by the governing body.

(2) A governing body that adopts the provisions of ORS 307.515 to 307.523 may adopt additional criteria for exemption that do not conflict with the criteria described in subsection (1)(a) to [(d)] (c) of this section.

SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 307.520 by section 1 of this 2025 Act apply to claims for exemption under ORS 307.520 for property tax years beginning on or after July 1, 2026.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
