House Bill 3254

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells ODVA to report on the amount of federal moneys the state receives for each dollar the state spends for veterans. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.6).

Requires the Department of Veterans' Affairs to report the amount of federal moneys the state receives for each dollar the state spends on outreach and programming for veterans and the amount of federal moneys received by service members and veterans in this state not later than December 1 of each year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to veterans.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> On or before December 1 of each year, the Department of Veterans' Affairs

5 shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the appropriate interim

6 committees of the Legislative Assembly. The report must describe, for the previous 12 7 months:

(2) The amount of moneys service members and veterans in this state receive for com pensation or retirement pay or pension from the Armed Forces of the United States or
