House Bill 3271

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act requires a study on the laws about energy incentives. The Act would require ODOE to submit a report of the results of the study by a certain date. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Directs the State Department of Energy to study laws related to energy incentives and provide the results to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2026. Sunsets January 2, 2027.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to the State Department of Energy; and prescribing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Energy shall conduct a study of laws related 5 to energy incentives. (2) The department shall provide the results of the study in a report to the appropriate 6 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2026. 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027. 9 SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 10

regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
