

House Bill 3277

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes the OMD do a study on military spouses and submit a report on its findings. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.6).

Requires the Oregon Military Department to study military spouses. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to veterans not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

Relating to military spouses.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Military Department shall study military spouses. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to veterans no later than September 15, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
