## House Bill 3282

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would make a third party study the OHA and provide ideas to make the OHA operate better. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.8).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to contract with a third party to examine restructuring of the authority to improve efficiency and responsiveness. Directs the authority to report the findings of the contractor to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health no later than September 15, 2026.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the restructuring of the Oregon Health Authority.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall contract with a third party that has experience and recognized expertise in corporate restructuring to examine the structure of the agency and make recommendation for changes to the structure to improve efficiency and responsiveness of the agency. The authority shall report the findings of the contractor, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, which may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health no later than September 15, 2026.
  - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

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
