House Bill 3284

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells an agency to create a program for buying trophy trout from certain facilities. The Act ends the program later. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.7).

Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish a program to purchase trophy trout from private aquaculture facilities.

Sunsets the program on January 2, 2031.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to aquaculture products; and declaring an emergency. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "trophy trout" means a trout that is at least 14 4 inches long or that weighs approximately one pound or more. 5 (2) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall establish a program to purchase 6 trophy trout from private aquaculture facilities. 7 (3) In implementing the program, the department shall: 8 9 (a) Annually purchase 500,000 pounds of trophy trout produced by private aquaculture facilities. 10 (b) Enter into purchase contracts with in-state private aquaculture facilities for a dura-11 tion of at least one year but not more than five years, as decided by the private aquaculture 12 facilities. 13(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3)(b) of this section, the department may purchase tro-14 phy trout from out-of-state private aquaculture facilities if in-state private aquaculture fa-1516 cilities are unable to provide sufficient trophy trout and the department provides in-state private aquaculture facilities with reasonable notice of the department's intent to purchase 17 18 trophy trout from out-of-state private aquaculture facilities. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2031. 19 SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 20 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 2122on its passage. 23
