

# House Bill 3289

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the DOC to study job training for persons upon release from custody. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Requires the Department of Corrections to study issues related to post-custodial workforce development in this state. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary not later than September 15, 2026.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to post-custodial workforce development.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Corrections shall study issues related to post-custodial**  
5 **workforce development in this state. The department shall submit a report in the manner**  
6 **provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim**  
7 **committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15,**  
8 **2026.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
