SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act gives money to DAS to give to the Human Access Project to mitigate harmful algal blooms. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.3).

[Digest: This Act gives money to HECC to give to OSU to mitigate harmful algal blooms. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.1).]

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the [Higher Education Coordinating Commission] Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to [Oregon State University] the Human Access Project for harmful algal bloom mitigation.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to harmful algal blooms; and prescribing an effective date.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July
- 6 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for distribution to the Human Access
- 7 Project to carry out, in partnership with Oregon State University, efforts to mitigate harm-
- ful algal blooms in the Ross Island lagoon:
 - (1) \$950,000 for engineering and permitting expenses.
 - (2) \$40,000 for Oregon State University project management expenses.
 - (3) \$30,000 for Human Access Project project management expenses.
- SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
