

House Bill 3320

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would require a study of the means of granting a tax break to emergency volunteers. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.1).

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study the means of granting a tax benefit to emergency management volunteers.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to emergency management volunteers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Revenue Officer shall conduct a study of potential means of**
5 **granting a tax benefit to emergency management volunteers. Not later than September 15,**
6 **2026, the officer shall submit a report of the findings of the study, in the manner provided**
7 **by ORS 192.245, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue,**
8 **and may include recommendations for legislation in the report.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
