# House Bill 3345

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that taxis and rideshare vehicles must have plates that have red letters and numbers. (Flesch Readability Score: 70.1).

Requires taxis and rideshare vehicles to have rideshare plates that have cherry red lettering and numbering.

Creates the offense of failure to display rideshare plates. Punishes by a maximum fine of \$250.

#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to vehicle registration plates; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 805.200 and

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle 6 Code.

SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section and ORS 805.200:

8 (a) "Rideshare vehicle" means a motor vehicle that is operated in affiliation with a 9 transportation network company.

10 (b) "Transportation network company" has the meaning given that term in ORS 742.518.

(2) A person commits the offense of failure to display rideshare plates issued under ORS
 805.200 if the person operates a taxi or a rideshare vehicle and rideshare plates are not dis-

13 played in the manner provided in ORS 803.540 for the display of registration plates.

(3) The requirement to display a rideshare plate under this section begins 30 days after
 the date a vehicle is first used as a taxi or rideshare vehicle.

(4) The offense described in this section, failure to display rideshare plates, is a Class D
 traffic violation.

18 **SECTION 3.** ORS 805.200 is amended to read:

19 805.200. (1) The Department of Transportation by rule:

(a) Shall design plates, stickers, plate and sticker combinations or other devices or indicia that
 distinguish government-owned vehicles registered under the provisions of ORS 805.040 from other
 vehicles.

(b) Shall provide for issuance of rideshare plates upon the request of vehicle owners of taxis and rideshare vehicles. The rideshare plates shall meet the requirements for registration plates described in ORS 803.535, except that the lettering and numbering must be cherry red in color to distinguish taxis and rideshare vehicles from other vehicles. The fee for issuance of rideshare plates is provided in ORS 805.250. When the motor vehicle is no longer used a taxi or rideshare vehicle, the owner shall return the plates issued under this paragraph to the department and instead receive other registration plates.

1 [(b)] (c) May design plates, stickers, plate and sticker combinations or other devices or indicia 2 for distinguishing vehicles registered under specific provisions of the Oregon Vehicle Code other 3 than ORS 805.040, 805.105 or 805.205. Plates designed under this paragraph shall comply with the 4 requirements of ORS 803.535. The fees for plates or indicia described in this paragraph are provided 5 under ORS 805.250.

6 (2) Unless otherwise provided by statute or by rule of the department, indicia of registration 7 that distinguish one kind of registration from another may not be transferred unless the new owner 8 of the vehicle qualifies for that specific kind of registration.

9 (3) The department may adopt rules concerning the disposition of plates, stickers, devices or 10 other indicia of registration upon transfer of ownership of the vehicle or when the owner or the 11 vehicle is no longer eligible for the particular indicia. The department may cancel or revoke regis-12 tration for failure to comply with rules adopted under this section.

SECTION 4. ORS 805.250 is amended to read:

14 805.250. This section establishes fees for issuance of registration plates authorized under ORS 15 805.200. If a fee for plates authorized in ORS 805.200 is not established in this section, the fee is the 16 same fee as established under ORS 803.570. Where a fee is established under this section, the fee 17 is in addition to the fee established under ORS 803.570 unless otherwise provided in the following:

18 (1) Amateur radio operator registration plates issued under ORS 805.230, \$5.

19 (2) Customized registration plates issued under ORS 805.240:

20 (a) For original issuance or renewal, \$50 annual fee.

21 (b) For issuance of a duplicate or replacement plate, \$12.

(3) Special interest registration plates approved under ORS 805.210 are approved without cost
except as provided in this subsection, including without payment of the fee established under ORS
803.570. If identifying stickers are required, \$1 per sticker or pair of stickers.

25 (4) Dealer plates issued under ORS 822.040 are as follows:

26 (a) For the original dealer plate, no fee except the fee established under ORS 803.570.

(b) For replacement dealer plates, \$10 for each plate except that persons dealing exclusively in
motorcycles, mopeds, snowmobiles or any combination of those vehicles shall pay only \$3 for each
replacement plate.

30 (c) For additional plates, or for renewal of registration, \$42, except that persons dealing exclu31 sively in motorcycles, mopeds or snowmobiles or any combination of those vehicles shall pay only
32 \$9 for each additional plate, or for renewal of registration.

(5) Special vehicle transporter plates or devices issued under ORS 822.310, \$5 for each plate or
 device.

(6) Rideshare plates issued under ORS 805.200:

36 (a) For original issuance or renewal, \$50 annual fee.
