

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3348

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 8, delete “419B.005.”
2 Delete lines 12 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:
3 “**NOTE:** Sections 1 and 2 were deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were not renun-
4 bered.”.
5 On page 22, delete lines 29 through 45.
6 On page 23, delete lines 1 through 13 and insert:
7 “**SECTION 21.** ORS 25.260 is amended to read:
8 “25.260. [(1) *As used in this section, ‘child support program’ means:*]
9 “[*(a) The program described in ORS 180.345;*]
10 “[*(b) The Administrator of the Division of Child Support of the Department of Justice;*]
11 “[*(c) A district attorney; and*]
12 “[*(d) The administrator’s or district attorney’s authorized representative.*]
13 “[**(2)** (1) Unless otherwise authorized by law, child support records, including data contained in
14 the **Oregon** Child Support Program’s automated system, are confidential and may be disclosed or
15 used only as necessary for the administration of the program.
16 “[**(3)** (2) In administering the **Oregon** Child Support Program, the program may:
17 “(a) In accordance with rules adopted under subsection [(7)] (6) of this section, report abuse as
18 defined in ORS 419B.005 if the abuse is discovered while providing program services.
19 “(b) Extract and [receive] **exchange** information from other databases as necessary to carry out
20 the program’s responsibilities under state and federal law.
21 “[**(4)** (3) The [*child support*] program may compare and share information with public and pri-
22 vate entities as necessary to [*perform*] **carry out** the program’s responsibilities under state and
23 federal law.
24 “[**(5)** (4) The [*child support*] program may exchange information with state agencies adminis-
25 tering the following programs as necessary for the **Oregon** Child Support Program and the state
26 agencies to perform their responsibilities under state and federal law:
27 “(a) Programs funded under Title IV, XIX or XXI of the Social Security Act; and
28 “(b) The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program under ORS 411.806 to 411.845.
29 “[**(6)** (5) In addition to any penalty to which an individual may be subject under ORS 25.990,
30 an employee of the Department of Justice, of a district attorney or of the Department of Human
31 Services who discloses or uses the contents of any records in violation of subsection [(2)] (1) of this
32 section is subject to discipline, up to and including dismissal from employment.
33 “[**(7)** (6) The Department of Justice shall adopt rules consistent with federal regulations gov-
34 erning confidentiality of **Oregon** Child Support Program information.”.
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
