House Bill 3498

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes changes to which acts are "abuse" of a child. (Flesch Readability Score: 95.9).

Modifies the definition of "abuse" for purposes of child abuse to remove the use of certain restraints on and seclusion of students.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

Sections 8, 12 and 14, chapter 581, Oregon Laws 2023, are repealed. 14 15 SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 16 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 17
