House Bill 3504

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives moneys to the TSPC to pay for new staff positions. (Flesch Readability Score: 83.0).

Appropriates moneys to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to fund nine additional full-time staff positions to support student safety and adult accountability in the education system.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, for the biennium beginning July

6 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,054,491, which may be expended to fund

7 nine additional full-time staff positions at the commission to support student safety and

8 adult accountability in the education system of this state.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
11 July 1, 2025.
