

House Bill 3515

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that the training for officers with guns has to include two hours of non-lethal techniques for each hour of lethal techniques. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.1).

Provides that the training required to obtain certification as a public safety officer armed with a firearm must include two hours of training in nonlethal techniques for each hour of training in lethal techniques.

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 181A.355 to**
5 **181A.689.**

6 **SECTION 2. The training required under ORS 181A.410 to obtain certification as a public**
7 **safety officer armed with a firearm must include two hours of training in nonlethal tech-**
8 **niques for each hour of training in lethal techniques.**
