On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 25 and insert: 1 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 2 "(a) 'Interested party' means an individual or entity with a right to property that may 3 be affected by a change of name pursuant to this section. 4 "(b) 'Offensive' means insulting and derogatory to any of Oregon's nine federally recog-5 nized Indian tribes or to any race, nationality or ethnicity. 6 "(2) The Oregon Historical Society shall: 7 "(a) Compile a list of highways as defined in ORS 801.305 and geographic features in-8 cluding, but not limited to, mountains, buttes, gulleys, gulches, rivers and creeks in Oregon 9 10 that bear offensive names; and "(b) Begin a process of determining new names for the highways and geographic features. 11 12 "(3)(a) In fulfilling its duties under subsection (2) of this section, the society shall consult 13 with: "(A) The Oregon Geographic Names Board; 14 15 "(B) Oregon's nine federally recognized Indian tribes; "(C) County and municipal leaders; 16 "(D) Representatives of state government; 17"(E) Local landowners; and 18 "(F) Interested parties. 19 "(b) Leaders and representatives shall be consulted only with respect to highways and 20geographic features within the jurisdictions they represent. 21"(4) The society shall submit proposals to the U.S. Board on Geographic Names recom-22mending names that are not offensive for all highways and geographic features on the list 23compiled under subsection (2)(a) of this section no later than the date that is three years 24 following the effective date of this 2025 Act.". 2526
