House Bill 3586

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates a cause of action against a person who removes a condom without consent. The Act takes effect on the 91st day after sine die. (Flesch Readability Score: 77.1).

Creates a civil cause of action against a person who removes a condom without the consent of the plaintiff.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to sexual battery; and prescribing an effective date.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) A plaintiff may bring a civil action for sexual battery against a person
5	if:
6	(a) The person engages in any form of sexual intercourse with the plaintiff;
7	(b) There is an agreement between the parties that a condom will be used during the
8	intercourse; and
9	(c) Prior to or during the intercourse, the person intentionally removes the condom
10	without the plaintiff's verbal consent, causing direct contact between a sexual organ, mouth
11	or anus of the plaintiff and a sexual organ of the person.
12	(2) A plaintiff who prevails in a cause of action for sexual battery under this section may
13	recover:
14	(a) Special and general damages, including damages for emotional distress;
15	(b) Punitive damages;
16	(c) Reasonable attorney fees and costs; and
17	(d) Any other appropriate equitable relief.
18	(3) As used in this section, "any form of sexual intercourse" means oral or anal sexual
19	intercourse or sexual intercourse as those terms are defined in ORS 163.305.
20	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act applies to conduct occurring on or after the ef-
21	fective date of this 2025 Act.
22	SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025

regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
