House Bill 3643

Sponsored by Representative ELMER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Creates a new state day to raise awareness of youth suicide. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.3).

Designates October 9 of each year as Oregon Youth Suicide Awareness Day. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Oregon Youth Suicide Awareness Day; and declaring an emergency.

3 Whereas the topic of youth suicide does not receive the elevation and attention it deserves; and

4 Whereas youth suicide has impacted far too many communities and families throughout our

5 beautiful state; and

6 Whereas the warning signs of youth suicide often go unnoticed or unrecognized; and

7 Whereas shame, stigma and a lack of knowledge are barriers to seeking professional mental 8 health support; and

9 Whereas 20 percent of all high school students have reported having serious thoughts about 10 suicide; and

11 Whereas in Oregon, 38 percent of high school juniors reported feeling so sad or hopeless they 12 stopped normal activities; and

13 Whereas 109 Oregon youths died by suicide in 2022; and

14 Whereas in 2022, Oregon had the 12th highest youth suicide rate in the nation; and

15 Whereas according to Mental Health America, Oregon ranks last in the nation in balancing the 16 prevalence of youth mental illness with access to care; and

Whereas suicide remains the second leading cause of death in the nation among people aged 5 to 24; and

19 Whereas Oregon must remain dedicated to ending the prevalence of youth suicide; and

20 Whereas the young lives we have lost to suicide live on in our hearts and memories; now, 21 therefore,

22 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

23 <u>SECTION 1.</u> October 9 of each year is designated as Oregon Youth Suicide Awareness
24 Day.

25 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 26 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect

27 on its passage.
