## House Bill 3647

Sponsored by Representative MUNOZ

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells gas station owners to display the prices they charge for fuel on a sign visible from the street and at each pump. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.4).

Requires a person that operates a service station, business or other place for the purpose of retailing and delivering gasoline, diesel or other fuel to display on a sign visible from the street and on a sign visible at or near each dispensing device the prices charged for all grades of gasoline, diesel or other fuel.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to price displays required for retail fuel dispensing stations; amending ORS 646.930.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 646.930 is amended to read:

5 646.930. (1) A person [who] that operates a service station, business or other place for the pur-

6 pose of retailing and delivering gasoline, diesel or other fuel into the tanks of motor vehicles[:]

7 [(a) May] shall display on a sign visible from the street and on a sign visible at or near each

8 dispensing device the [lowest cash] prices charged for the sale of [the lowest] all grades of gasoline,
9 diesel or other fuel.

10 [(b) If a sign is displayed under paragraph (a) of this subsection, shall display on a sign visible 11 at or near any dispensing device all prices charged for the sale of all grades of gasoline, diesel or other 12 fuel offered for sale.]

13 (2) The following apply to a sign displaying prices under this section:

(a) The price per unit of measurement and the unit of measurement for a particular kind of fuel
must be the same on the sign as on any dispensing device used for delivering that kind of fuel into
the tanks of motor vehicles.

(b) If a [cash] price displayed on a sign is available only under some conditions, the sign and the
dispensing device must clearly state the conditions.

(c) If a price displayed on a sign is available only in a certain area of the service station orbusiness, the area where the price displayed is available must be clearly identified.

(3) A person who displays a [cash] price that is available only under some conditions may not
require, as a condition of buying fuel at the displayed price, that the buyer fill the fuel tank of the
buyer's vehicle.
