## House Bill 3671

Sponsored by Representative EDWARDS

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DHS to study ways to fund senior centers. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.3). Requires the Department of Human Services to study the ways to fund senior centers in Oregon. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services not later than September 15, 2026. Sunsets January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to senior centers.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall study ways to fund the operation of senior centers in Oregon. The department shall submit a report on the findings in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services no later than September 15, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
