House Bill 3676

Sponsored by Representative EDWARDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act tells OHA to create a grant program for small city drinking and waste water facilities. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.1).

Directs the Oregon Health Authority, in coordination with the Department of Environmental Quality, to establish a program to provide grants to repair or replace certain community drinking water and wastewater facilities.

Establishes the Small Community Water Infrastructure Fund.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to a grant program for community water infrastructure. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: **SECTION 1.** (1) As used in this section: 4 (a) "Eligible community" means a city with a population of less than 20,000. 5 (b) "Sewage treatment works" has the meaning given that term in ORS 448.405. 6 (c) "Water system" has the meaning given that term in ORS 448.405. 7 (2) The Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with the Department of Environmental 8 Quality, shall establish a program to provide grants to eligible communities to repair or re-9 place water systems or sewage treatment works. 10 11 (3) An application for a grant under this section shall be made in the form and manner prescribed by the authority. Before awarding a grant under this section for the repair or 12 replacement of sewage treatment works, the authority must provide a copy of the grant ap-13plication to the department for comment. 14 (4) Grants awarded under this section shall be made from moneys credited to or depos-15ited in the Small Community Water Infrastructure Fund established under section 2 of this 16 2025 Act. 17 18 (5) The authority, in consultation with the department, may adopt rules as necessary for the administration of this section. 19 SECTION 2. (1) The Small Community Water Infrastructure Fund is established in the 20 21State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Small 22Community Water Infrastructure Fund shall be credited to the fund. 23(2) Moneys in the fund shall consist of: (a) Amounts appropriated or otherwise transferred to the fund by the Legislative As-24 25sembly; and 26(b) Other amounts deposited in the fund from any public or private source. 27(3) Moneys in the Small Community Water Infrastructure Fund are continuously appro-28 priated to the Oregon Health Authority for the purpose of awarding grants under section 1
