## House Bill 3719

Sponsored by Representative ANDERSEN

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This bill makes OHCS study housing for people with substance use disorders. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.9).

Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to study housing for individuals with substance use disorders and submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to housing no later than September 15, 2026.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to housing for individuals with substance use disorders. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Housing and Community Services Department shall study housing for individuals with substance use disorders and shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to housing no later than September 15, 2026. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
