## House Bill 3732

Sponsored by Representative HARTMAN

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DOT to make an intersection safer. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Transportation for safety improvements at a specified intersection in Gladstone.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to state financial administration; and prescribing an effective date.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,000,000 to be used for safety improvements related to the intersection of McLoughlin Boulevard, River Road and West Arlington Street in Gladstone.
  - SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
