

# House Bill 3732

Sponsored by Representative HARTMAN

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DOT to make an intersection safer. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Transportation for safety improvements at a specified intersection in Gladstone.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Department of Transportation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**  
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$4,000,000 to be used for safety improvements related to the**  
7 **intersection of McLoughlin Boulevard, River Road and West Arlington Street in Gladstone.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025**  
9 **regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
