House Bill 3736

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DAS to look at more cost effective ways for agencies to get translation services and make a report. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.0).

Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study more cost effective ways for state agencies to procure translation services. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to general government no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to translation services.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall study more cost

effective ways for state agencies to procure accessible and accurate translation services. The
study must examine ways to use technology as a resource. The department shall submit a

7 report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legis-

8 lation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to general government

9 no later than September 15, 2026.

10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
