House Bill 3771

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes the SCIO do a study on AI and submit a report. (Flesch Readability Score: 81.8). Requires the State Chief Information Officer to study artificial intelligence. Directs the officer to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to information management and technology not later than September 15, 2026. Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the regulation of artificial intelligence.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Chief Information Officer shall study artificial intelligence. The officer shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to information management and technology no later than September 15, 2026.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
