House Bill 3821

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would require a study of the security upgrade needs of small businesses in Oregon. A report will be due by September 15 of next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.5).

Requires the Oregon Business Development Department to study the security upgrade needs of small businesses in Oregon. Directs the department to submit a report of the study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to small business security.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3
 - SECTION 1. The Oregon Business Development Department shall conduct a study of the security upgrade needs of small businesses in Oregon. The department shall submit a report of its findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2026.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
